Vision Committee

The Vision Committee met on February 21st and was encouraged by the first selectman of Madison, Mr. Tom Banisch, as he continues to express a desire to assist OLM with our relocation project. John Picard, a member of the Vision Committee, has been in contact with Mr. Banisch and received the following message from the First Selectman which he asked be shared with the OLM community:

"Iohn,

Just a quick note to let you know that the Town of Madison is interested in helping OLM find an answer to their dilemma sooner rather than later. We realize that timing is a crucial aspect of their situation, and while I can't give you any assurances by way of a timetable right now, I can tell you that I've spoken with our superintendent Tom Scarice, who shares with me the understanding of the importance of this situation and the need to address it in the short term.

Madison is expecting to close at least one school in the near future, and we believe that we could work with OLM to relocate them there. We realize that timing is critical, so we are looking at all possibilities for helping OLM remain in Madison."

OLM is truly blessed to have the support of town officials as we move ahead with our project. The Vision committee will next meet on Saturday, February 27.
